## THE SAN DIEGO PUBLIC LIBRARY SCREENS 'WHERE SOLDIERS COME FROM' TO COMMEMORATE VETERANS DAY A Moving Portrayal of the Effects of War on the Nation's Young People

**SAN DIEGO** – The Student Veterans of America chapter at Thomas Jefferson Law School, the San Diego Public Library, and PBS' Point-of-View (POV) Series, will host a special Veterans Day preview screening of the film *Where Soldiers Come From* on Thursday, November 10, 2011 at 3:00 p.m. in the 3rd floor auditorium of the Central Library, located at 820 E Street in downtown San Diego. After the film, speakers from the SVA will lead a discussion exploring the themes in the film and the issues that confront returning soldiers. This free event is open to the public.

From a snowy, small town in northern Michigan to the mountains of Afghanistan, in *Where Soldiers Come From*, filmmaker Heather Courtney follows the four-year journey of childhood friends who join the National Guard after graduating from high school. As it chronicles the young men's transformation from restless teenagers to soldiers looking for roadside bombs to 23-year-old combat veterans trying to start their lives again, the film offers an intimate look at the young Americans who fight our wars, the families and towns they come from — and the way one faraway conflict changes everything.
