California Consort Opens Central Library Winter/Spring Concert Series *Ensemble to Perform Music for Piano Quintet by Schubert and Hummel*

SAN DIEGO – The 2012 Winter/Spring Concert Series of the City of San Diego Public Library will open Sunday, January 29 with a performance by the California Consort (Karen Follingstad, piano; Alyze Dreiling, violin; Susan Ung, viola; Lorie Kirkell, cello; Bert Turetzky, double bass) in a rare performance of music from Schubert’s famous “Trout” Quintet from 1819, and Johann Nepomuk Hummel’s earlier, lesser known Piano Quintet from 1802.
