Celebrating the importance of our local libraries, the San Diego Latino Film Festival welcomes every reader to Library Night. Inspired by *One Book One San Diego*, the Festival schedules films that will inspire readers as well as remind the community the value of public libraries as vibrant life-long community learning centers. Twelve films from several countries, Venezuela, Dominican Republic, Argentina, Peru, Cuba, Mexico, Spain, and Chile will be screened for the pleasures of library patrons.
