Free Opportunity for High School Students to Boost Their Chances of Successful College Admission

SAN DIEGO – The San Diego Public Library is excited to announce the second installment of *Admit One College Prep Academy*, a program aimed at giving high school students a jump start on the college admissions process. This series will be hosted at our Logan Heights Branch Library located on 567 South 28th Street in San Diego, CA 92113 from **April 8 through April 27**. The comprehensive nine-session program includes practice tests for the SAT and the ACT by the Princeton Review, SAT and ACT test prep sessions by Cal-SOAP as well as information sessions on key topics by speaker, college admissions expert and author of *adMission Possible*, **Marjorie Hansen Shaevitz** and a special presentation on financial aid by speaker, college expert and author of *The College Solution: A Guide for Everyone Looking for the Right School at the Right Price*, **Lynn O'Shaughnessy**. The final session will include a graduation celebration for completing the program with representatives from local colleges and special guest keynote speaker, **Dr. Ron Baza**, Executive Board Member of UC San Diego's Chancellor's Community Advisory Board.
