### **The Ella Quartet to Present Inaugural Concert at New Central Library** *Fall Opener Features San Diego Symphony String Performers Playing Haydn and Prokofiev*

**SAN DIEGO** – The 2013 Fall Concert Series of the City of San Diego Public Library will open Sunday, September 29, 2013 with the Ella Quartet performing a recital of string quartets by Haydn and Prokofiev. The Ella Quartet is a stellar ensemble of musicians from the San Diego Symphony string section: Jisun Yang, first violin and Assistant Concertmaster; Julie Pautz, second violin; Gareth Zehngut, viola; and Marcia Bookstein, cello.

The FREE program will be held at 2:30 p.m. in the auditorium of the new Central Library, 330 Park Boulevard at 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue near Petco Park. The recital starts at 2:30 p.m. and lasts about one hour with no intermission. Details of the program follow:

Sergey Prokofiev, String Quartet No. 2 in F Major, Op. 92

The 2013 Fall Concert Series is the first concert series to be presented in San Diego Public Library's new Central Library. During the inaugural fall season, performers from some of the finest ensembles in San Diego will perform, including San Diego Symphony, Bach Collegium, San Diego Master Chorale, Hausmann Quartet, San Diego Children's Choir, and Camarada.
