


Special Screening...

“Delano Manongs”

Directed by Emmy-Award winner Marissa Aroy, **Delano Manongs** tells the story of the Delano Grape Strike of 1965 when Filipino labor organizers, Larry Itliong and Philip Vera Cruz, organized a group of 1500 Filipinos to strike against the grape growers of Delano, California for unfair labor practices. When Chicano workers led by Cesar Chavez joined in, this impetus created the United Farm Workers. The collaboration between Filipinos, Chicanos and other ethnic workers changed the nation for the better.
