**Winners of Annual Goodlin Scholarship Competition  
to Perform at Central Library on May 14**

SAN DIEGO – For the final program of its Winter/Spring Concert Series, the San Diego Public Library will present a performance by the winners of the Goodlin Scholarship Competition. The free concert will take place Sunday, May 14, at 2:30 p.m., in the third floor auditorium of the Central Library, located at 820 E St. in downtown San Diego.

The H.B. Goodlin Foundation was started by the San Diego chapter of the Music Teachers' Association of California, at the bequest of Helen Goodlin. The Foundation provides scholarships for young musicians from San Diego County, and awards prizes to the winners of the annual scholarship auditions.

The San Diego Public Library began its Chamber Music Series in the mid-1950s. Critical and popular response encouraged the Library to increase the scope of the series to its present status of a Fall Concert Series and a Winter/Spring Concert Series. These musical series are funded by a donation from the Herbert Feurerisen Family and other public donors.
