Library to Present Class on “House Exchanging” – A Unique Way to Spend Your Vacation

SAN DIEGO – Are you ready for an unforgettable yet inexpensive vacation? Wouldn't you like to spend your next holiday for free at a beach house, a mountain getaway, an apartment in Paris or London, a country home in Ireland, a ranch in Texas or a home in Australia or New Zealand from which to explore the country?

The City of San Diego Public Library will host a class on “House Exchanging” on Wednesday, July 5, from 6 to 7:30 p.m., in the third floor auditorium of the Central Library, located at 820 E St. in downtown San Diego. This event is free to the public.

House exchanging is the unique vacation experience where you visit another country or state and live in the home of a fellow exchanger while they live in yours. This arrangement potentially saves each party thousands of dollars in vacation expenses (no hotel bills, reduced food costs and often no rental car fees), and also provides opportunities that would not be available to a regular tourist, such as meeting their friends and neighbors, shopping in the local markets, and participating in the life of a community.
