Grand Re-Opening of the Otay Mesa-Nestor Branch Library

WHAT: A grand re-opening ceremony for the Otay Mesa-Nestor Branch Library following a major expansion and renovation. The ceremony will include presentations by City officials and community residents, as well as musical entertainment by the Mariachi Band of Montgomery High School. The Otay Mesa-Nestor Branch Library will also host a solo exhibition of 30 recent paintings and pastel drawings by Lynn Schuette, one of San Diego's most accomplished artists.

WHEN: FRIDAY, APRIL 7 at 2:30 p.m.

WHERE: Otay Mesa-Nestor Branch Library, located at 3003 Coronado Ave.

WHY: The branch library was expanded from 10,000 square feet to 15,000 square feet to better serve the communities. The renovated facility will include an expanded meeting and conference space, a computer lab, and additional space for growing collections in English, Spanish, Tagalog, and recently added Vietnamese materials. The renovated library now also includes a tranquil courtyard area. This project is part of the citywide program to revitalize its library system.
