**Handmade Books Made by Children Artists
to be on Display at City Heights Library**
Library Visitors on Oct. 6 and 20 Can Create Their Own Books

SAN DIEGO – An exhibition of handmade books created by children artists will be on display at the City Heights-Weingart Branch Library from Oct. 1 through Nov. 30. Each year, San Diego Book Arts sponsors a project in which the organization’s members work with young people to make artists’ books.

The City Heights-Weingart Branch, which serves the largest juvenile population in the City, will be the first stop on a six-library tour of artist’s book exhibitions. San Diego Book Arts members will be at the library on from 1 to 3:45 p.m. on both Oct. 6 and 20. Visitors to the library during that time will be able to construct their own accordion-style book about verbs, titled “Flip It.”

The City Heights Branch is located at 3795 Fairmont Ave. Library hours are Sunday from 1 to 5 p.m.; Monday and Wednesday, noon to 8 p.m.; and Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday, 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. For more information, call the library 619-641-6100.

In November and December, the program’s focus will shift to the Valencia Park-Malcolm X Branch Library, the first venue for the four-library traveling exhibition of San Diego Book Arts members’ creations. The exhibit will also be on display at Linda Vista (January-February), Mira Mesa Branch (March-April) and Allied Gardens-Benjamin Branch (May-June). The student artist’s book exhibit will also be at the San Ysidro Branch, however the dates have not yet been scheduled.
