Adventurous Horse and Mule Riders and Their Animals to Visit Library *Bernie Harberts and Lisa Wood to Discuss Their Riding Adventures on June 11*

SAN DIEGO – Bernie Harberts, who rode a mule across the United States, and Lisa Wood, who rode a horse the length of the California coast, will discuss their adventures at the La Jolla/Riford Branch Library on Saturday, June 11 at 10 a.m. Their animals will also be at the event.

Last year, Harberts left North Carolina on a 13-month trip with his mule Woody and a pony named Magnolia and arrived in San Diego on April 10. Along the way he met many interesting people and saw America in a different way than most. Before this adventure, Harberts sailed around the world on a 34-foot sailboat.

In 1991, Wood rode an appaloosa named Cacho along the California coast from San Diego to the Oregon border. She published her story in a book in 2001 entitled “Chasing the California Dream.” She later rode a mustang from California to Virginia, and the chronicle of that trip is scheduled to be published this summer.

Both adventurers will discuss their journeys, their unique perspectives and their future plans.
