### **Mystery Author Jeff Sherratt to Discuss His Book “One, Two & Even” at Central Library**

**SAN DIEGO** – The City of San Diego Public Library will host a book discussion with mystery author Jeff Sherratt on Wednesday, April 13, at 6:30 p.m. in the Wangenheim Room on the third floor of the Central Library. The event is free and open to the public.

Sherratt, a former businessman who once tried his hand as a political consultant in a public relations firm, has crafted a series of suspenseful books, featuring Jimmy O’Brien – an ex-cop and amateur defense attorney. Like his earlier titles, Sherratt’s latest offering, “One, Two & Even,” draws on his experience in the world of politics to create a setting awash in mystery and intrigue.

Sherratt’s latest book finds O’Brien – who seems to forever be in hot water with the local political machine – knee deep in trouble after a prostitute’s husband is shot in the head. Complicating matters is another client, who has died in police custody. Officials say it’s a suicide but O’Brien isn’t so sure.

Born in Los Angeles, Sherratt had completed a successful business career when his daughter dared him to begin writing mystery novels. She was tired of hearing him complain that the mysteries he was reading weren’t up to snuff. As a result, Sherratt created Jimmy O’Brien, an ex-cop and defense attorney who always seems to be in trouble. The first book in the series was “Six to Five Against.”
