Only recommended titles are added to the Center's collection and become part of the searchable database accessible through the San Diego Public Library's Web site at www.sandiego.gov/public-library/services/ischoncenter.shtml. The International Center for Spanish Books for Youth provides access to both scholarly and recreational books. The Center's efforts are integrated into existing San Diego Public Library literacy programs such as the Summer Reading Program and READ/San Diego (the Library's literacy program).

Founder

The late Dr. Isabel Schon was the Center's founder and first director. The author of 25 books and more than 400 research and literary articles, Dr. Schon received numerous awards and her reviews are still widely read and well respected in the publishing community. Her legacy lives on through the outstanding materials selected for the San Diego Public Library based on quality of writing and illustration, presentation of material, and audience appeal.
