


YOU CAN HELP SUPPORT THE SAN DIEGO PUBLIC LIBRARY'S VISUAL ARTS PROGRAM!



FACTS YOU SHOULD KNOW:

- ▶ The Visual Arts Program, established in 1997, is a unique, nationally recognized program of museum quality art exhibitions held in libraries that are part of the San Diego Public Library system.
- ▶ The library's Visual Arts Program is the only endeavor in San Diego dedicated solely to exhibiting art created by the city's serious, mid-career and older contemporary artists.
- ▶ The Visual Arts Program builds on the synergy between libraries and the visual arts to bring exposure to San Diego's large, under-recognized population of contemporary artists, while providing quality cultural programming to library users and the art community.
- ▶ Visual Arts Program exhibitions are widely publicized and attract viewers from a large geographical area to neighborhood libraries.
- ▶ In addition to exhibitions, other Visual Arts Program activities include free artists' lectures and an art and music concert series.
- ▶ The Visual Arts Program will soon begin construction of a major website that will be a resource for scholars, students, collectors, artists, and members of the general public seeking information on San Diego-area artists and images of their work. The website will also include information on past, current, and future exhibitions; the Library's Permanent Collection; archived videos of the artists' television interviews; donor information; the history of the Visual Arts Program etc.
- ▶ Under the guidance of the Visual Arts Program, the San Diego Public Library system is building a permanent collection of major contemporary works by San Diego artists. A percentage of Visual Arts Program revenues, supplemented by private donations, is used to acquire new works.
- ▶ The concept of the Visual Arts Program can be expanded throughout the library system. Because of the success of the program, the Logan Heights Branch Library was built with gallery space and other new branches in the design phase are considering the capability to exhibit art.
- ▶ More than 150 exhibitions featuring San Diego's mid-career and older professional artists have been organized under the auspices of the Visual Arts Program since its inception in 1997.
- ▶ A state-of-the art, 3,500 sq.ft. gallery, plus a rooftop sculpture garden, will be major features of the new Central Library and will be incorporated into Visual Arts Program operations. The gallery will be located on the top (ninth) floor, overlooking the city. This will be one of the premier exhibition spaces in the city and will serve generations of library users and the art community.

- ▶ An adjunct function of the Visual Arts Program is to encourage scholarly examination of San Diego-area artists.
- ▶ The Visual Arts Program has received national attention for its uniquely entrepreneurial approach to cultural programming in public libraries. Supporting the Visual Arts Program by purchasing works of art through library venues and making cash donations to the Program is one of the most effective ways of assisting San Diego-area artists, boosting the local economy through the visual arts, and enhancing the role of the city's public libraries as cultural centers.

▶ The Visual Arts Program is largely dependent on a modest commission from art sales, augmented by grass-roots donations from the community, to fund its daily operating expenses. To fulfill its much-needed mission in the community, the Visual Arts Program needs your support.
