Library's Free "Winter/Spring Concert Series" Schedule Announced *Celebration of Mozart's 250th Birthday to Kick Off the Series*

SAN DIEGO – The 2006 Winter/Spring Concert Series of the City of San Diego Public Library will premiere Sunday, Jan. 29 with a celebration of Wolfgang Mozart's 250th birthday and music. The program will be held at 2:30 p.m. in the third floor auditorium of the Central Library, 820 E St., in downtown San Diego.

The trio of Robert Marcus, clarinet; William de Malignon, cello; and Ilana Mysior, piano; will perform selected music by Mozart. Theirs will be the first of seven concerts that will make up the series.

The Library began its Chamber Music Series in the mid-1950s. Critical and popular response encouraged the Library to increase the scope of the series to its present status of a Fall Concert Series and a Winter/Spring Concert Series. These musical series are funded by a donation from the Herbert Feurerisen Family and other public donors.

The concerts are very important to the musicians as they provide a venue for them to perform locally. The community has responded enthusiastically as shown by steadily growing attendance by musicians, music lovers, music appreciation students and other San Diego residents.

The full schedule of the Winter/Spring Concert Series is as follows:

- **Sunday, Jan. 29 at 2:30 p.m.**
A celebration of Mozart's 250th birthday with a performance by Robert Marcus, clarinet; William de Malignon, cello; and Ilana Mysior, piano.
- **Sunday, Feb. 12 at 2:30 p.m.**
Classical guitarist Robert Wetzel will perform works by Milan, Mudarra, Narvaez, Sor and Broca.
- **Sunday, Feb. 26 at 2:30 p.m.**
Pianist James Gary will perform works by Scriabin, Rachmaninoff and Mozart.
- **Sunday, March 12 at 2:30 p.m.**
The Piano Trio – featuring Emma Rubenstein, violin; Thomas Stauffer, cello; and Cynthia Darby, piano – will perform works by Haydn and Mendelssohn.

- **Sunday, April 9 at 2:30 p.m.**
Ronald Goldman, violin; Adam Burnbaum, viola; and Ben Pfeifer, cello; will perform string trios by Beethoven and Dohnanyi
- **Sunday, May 14 at 2:30 p.m.**
Performances by recipients of Goodlin Scholarships, awarded annually by the Music Teachers' Association of California, San Diego branch
