Age Category

- A: Elementary - K to 5th grade
- B: Middle - 6th to 8th grade
- C: High - 9th to 12th grade

chosen from the Southern California region.

NAHRO contest and the Grand Prize award:

- 12 National Honorees will receive \$100 savings bond
