SUBJECT: Cancellation of August 10<sup>th</sup> Stakeholders Meeting

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The calibration and modeling for existing traffic conditions and preparation of the traffic model for the year 2030 existing community plan conditions is due to be complete by the middle of August. Preparation of additional traffic models for the land use scenarios that have presented previously will begin in September and should be completed by early to mid October.

Because there are a number of additional community plan updates in process throughout the City of San Diego and limited staff to create these models, work on the Grantville Master Plan process cannot be completed any sooner. As such, like last month, we will not have any new traffic related information to present to the community at the August 10<sup>th</sup> stakeholders committee meeting.

The economic analysis of the three land use alternatives is still ongoing as well and should be completed by end of August. Next steps for the Grantville Master Plan process will include discussion of the traffic models and economic analysis, and beginning the process for the Environmental Impact Report (EIR). A Notice of Preparation for the EIR and scheduling of a public Scoping Meeting will be scheduled at a later date.
