
Fox Canyon Proposed Maps

- United City Heights Core plus three (3) map options
- All options are geographically compact and have contiguous territory
- All have excellent access between population centers
- Serving “***Communities of Interest***” as defined by themselves.
- Each option retains common activities, social and lifestyle patterns typically desired by members of the area.
- With the exception of **Option # 3**, all other use U.S, Census data to support plan proposal.
- Communities of Interest within each option need to step in to express desire to be within their preferred option.

District 9


Proposed **United City Heights Core District**, Population **99,992**

Area: Hwy 805 to 54th Street and Hwy 8 to MLK 94




CITY HEIGHTS CORE + OPTION # 1
