REDISTRICTING COMMISSION ADOPTS PRELIMINARY PLAN – FINAL ROUND OF PUBLIC HEARINGS TO BE HELD

WHAT: The City of San Diego Redistricting Commission adopted a preliminary redistricting plan yesterday that sets forth new boundaries for nine San Diego City Council districts.

The preliminary plan, including maps, demographic reports, and filing statement, is on file with the City Clerk's Office and can also be found online at www.sandiego.gov/redistricting.

The Commission is holding a series of five public hearings throughout San Diego from July 26 to August 3, including two simulcast in Spanish. Detailed directions and wayfinding information is available on the Commission web site.

WHY: These hearings provide an opportunity to learn about the preliminary redistricting plan and to give testimony that the Commission will consider in its final deliberations prior to adopting a final plan, expected in late August.

VISUALS: Maps showing new proposed district boundaries to be broadcast to the public. Public testimony and one-on-one interviews with residents, community leaders and other stakeholders present at the public meetings.
