This plan was created, in an effort to facilitate good public policy and redistricting changes at the San Diego City Redistricting Commission. This plan creates a logical split of Rancho Peñasquitos between a new District 5 and District 7, creating a new border at Carmel Mountain Road, the I-15 and the 56 Freeway. This plan recognizes the COI of Poway Unified, as well as the claims of the Asian community to Rancho Peñasquitos as a COI with Mira Mesa.
