

PAD Program Management Pricing

Phase I (not included in PAD Program Management fee) Certification Training

Minimal requirement for CPR/AED certification training must be met according to CA State law (CCR 1797.196).

Depending on the number of AEDs you have on site, the law requires that you certify one person per each AED up to five units. After the first five AEDs, only one additional person needs to be certified for every additional group of five thereafter.

San Diego Project Heart Beat offers on site classes and personalized online certification training.

PHASE II

PAD Program Management

Initiated annually through a Service Level Agreement (SLA).

First year of service: \$150 for first AED.

\$25 for each additional AED added to SLA up to ten.

\$10 for each additional AED added to SLA after the initial ten.

Annual reinstatement of service: Provides a discounted rate of \$100 for first AED on the SLA.

Service includes:

- Physician Medical Oversight
- Service Level Agreement
- 24hr. AED Emergency Contact Service
- Electronic and hard-copy record keeping for AED and Program Management
- Liaison orientation training on "Your AED Program"



- Free in-service training

PHASE III

Incident Management

(Included in PAD Program Management during normal business hours. Additional fees may apply after normal business hours.)

Includes:

- On-site Downloading of Data
- Replacement of Electrodes (additional fee)
- Processing and Filing of Required Reports (4)
- CISD (Critical Incident Stress Debriefing)
