On April 24, 2014, Development Services Staff **APPROVED** an application for a Substantial Conformance Review (SCR) (Process Two) for channel maintenance under the Master Storm Water System Maintenance Program (MSWSMP) to provide flood control for the protection of life and property. The project includes work within Murphy Canyon Creek channels adjacent to Qualcomm Stadium and Interstate-15. The property is located in the vicinity of 9355 Friars Road, San Diego, CA 92108, and is within the MV-CV (Commercial Visitor) and MV-I (Industrial) zones of the Mission Valley Planned District.

This project is within the scope of the MSWSMP, Program Environmental Impact Report No. 42891/SCH No. 2004101032, Certified on October 24, 2011, This Program Environmental Impact Report adequately describes the activity for the purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
