



Ms. Kolb has 30 years of experience in the environmental field and currently oversees storm water enforcement activities and policy development, including Total Maximum Daily Load coordination, contaminated sediment oversight, Areas of Special Biological Significance, Biological Objectives development, and other special projects as needed.

**Andre Sonksen** is the Program Manager for the Monitoring & Inspections Section of the City of San Diego's Transportation & Storm Water Department. He oversees commercial and industrial inspections and water quality monitoring. Mr. Sonksen started in storm water in 2002 as a biologist and has been involved with the City's storm water industrial program since 2004.

**Matt O'Malley** is the Waterkeeper and Legal & Policy Director for San Diego Coastkeeper. He has been involved in municipal and industrial storm water regulation and enforcement for the past 8 years in Florida and California.
