STUDENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO CREATE COLORFUL POSTERS FOR THE ANNUAL WATER CONSERVATION POSTER CONTEST

SAN DIEGO – The City of San Diego Water Department is announcing that the deadline for the very popular Water Conservation Poster Contest will be Friday, April 2, 2004. The contest is an annual event held for all first through sixth grade students attending public and private schools (including home-schooled students) within the City of San Diego.

The theme for this year's contest is "Water, Use it Wisely!" Participation in the contest challenges students and teachers to think about where our water comes from, how we use our limited supply, and how we can make simple changes to make every drop count. The goal of the contest is to help students realize the import role water plays in our every day lives, discover ways to save water and encourage them to practice water conservation on a daily basis.

Each student creating a poster to enter into the contest will receive a certificate of participation. Winners of the poster contest will receive a U.S. Savings Bond, a Certificate of Excellence, four tickets to the Reuben H. Fleet Science Center and one free meal at Rubio's Mexican Grill. An awards ceremony to honor winners of the poster contest will be held during May, in observance of Water Awareness Month, actual date, time and location of the ceremony will be announced.
