**SAN DIEGO-** Elementary schools throughout San Diego are educating students about the importance of water conservation by showcasing winning posters from the annual Water Conservation Poster Contest. Open to all first through sixth grade students in the City of San Diego, this fun and educational contest was established in 2000 to help teach children the importance of water and how to use it wisely. Each year the contest selects three posters from each grade as "winners." All 18 winning posters from the 2006 contest will be displayed throughout San Diego school libraries, auditoriums, and cafeterias.

"We like to display their posters at different community venues as a way to share them with San Diegans throughout the year," says Luis Generoso, Water Resources Manager. "We're thrilled to have the posters at the schools and hope they will inspire other students to participate in the contest next year, and to motivate them to start saving water at an early age."
