# **Eighth Annual Water Conservation Poster Contest Student Winners Honored**

The ceremony will honor the 18 outstanding student-artists who won this year's contest and will include their proud teachers and family.

Held each year by the City of San Diego Water Department, the poster contest provides a focal point for teachers to talk with their students about the importance of using water wisely. This year's "Water Wins!" theme gave thousands of students the opportunity to artistically illustrate meaningful water conservation messages by creating original artwork.
