City's Water Department Offering Free California-Friendly Gardening Classes for Residential Customers

SAN DIEGO - The City of San Diego Water Department is offering a series of free classes designed to help gardeners save water (and money) while making decisions about their home landscaping. The classes, being presented in conjunction with the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, will help homeowners choose colorful, healthy and attractive low-water use plants for their gardens.

The first class, **California Friendly Gardening for the Water Wise Gardener**, will be an overview of basic concepts for water-wise landscape design. Each of the three sessions being offered will cover the same topics. The sessions are scheduled for:
