Ninth Annual Water Conservation Poster Contest Student Winners Honored

SAN DIEGO - City of San Diego Mayor Jerry Sanders, Council President Ben Hueso, Councilmember Donna Frye, and the entire San Diego City Council will celebrate the creative efforts of the winners of the Ninth Annual Children's Water Conservation Poster Contest on **May 5**, 2009 at 10 a.m., in the City Administration Building Council Chambers on the 12th floor, 202 C Street. The ceremony will honor the 18 outstanding student-artists who won this year's contest and will include their proud teachers and family.

Held each year by the City of San Diego Water Department, the poster contest provides a focal point for teachers to talk with their students about the importance of using water wisely. This year's "Living In A Drought" theme gave thousands of students the opportunity to artistically illustrate meaningful water conservation messages by creating original artwork.

Mayor Jerry Sanders, Council President Hueso and Councilmember Frye will present each winner with an awards package including a U.S. Savings Bond, four tickets to the Reuben H.
