


Join the City of San Diego's Public Utilities Department to inspire San Diegans to "Waste No Water." Your entry could be the winning film that will be shown in theaters this summer.

FINALISTS — The finalists' films will be shown at a "Red Carpet Premiere" at the IMAX Theater in Balboa Park and will also be featured on the City of San Diego's website.

GRAND PRIZE — The winning film will be announced at the "Red Carpet Premiere" and shown in select movie theaters this summer.
