## Subject: Approval of EBAA Iron, Inc. Joint Restraint Products for the Water Approved Materials List

This letter is in response to your application submitted on November 23, 2011, in which your firm requested the City of San Diego (City) to evaluate and approve EBAA Iron, Inc. Joint Restraint products.

The City has completed the review of this application and determined that adequate data has been presented to approve the EBAA Iron, Inc. Pipe Restraint Series 1900 for C900 PVC pipe (4 to 12 inch), Series 2000PV Mechanical Joint Restraint for PVC pipe, Flex-900 flexible ball joint and Flex-Tend and Flex-Tend Forced Balanced flexible expansion joint (2 to 48 inch) for DI, PVC, Steel and HDPE pipe.

The approval of these products for use on the City of San Diego's water system is effective as of the date of this letter and will be included in the next Water Approved Materials List update.

The acceptance and approval of EBAA Iron, Inc. products are contingent on the following conditions:

- 1) The EBAA Iron, Inc. Joint Restraint products are manufactured and assembled at 702-30 Country Road 442, Eastland, Texas 76448.
- 2) EBAA Iron, Inc. shall notify the City in advance of any changes in the products, ownership, or location of the manufacturing plant.
- 3) EBAA Iron, Inc. shall provide application/installation procedures for the products to ensure the products meet the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction (Greenbook) and the City's Whitebook 2012. The installer shall meet the specification

conditions required for the proper installation of products as specified by EBAA Iron, Inc. or any of EBAA Iron, Inc.'s authorized suppliers.

4) Any unilateral action by EBAA Iron, Inc. without prior consultation and agreement from the City regarding the above mentioned conditions and limitations shall constitute a breach of agreement resulting in the removal of EBAA Iron, Inc. products from the City's Water Approved Materials List.
