Subject: Approval of Romac Industries' Coupling for the Water Approved Materials List

This is in response to your application submitted on September 12, 2011 in which you requested the City of San Diego (City) to evaluate and approve the Romac Industries, Inc., products.

The City has completed the review of this application and determined that adequate information has been presented to approve the Romac style 501 couplings, Romac EC501 end cap coupling, and Romac FCA501 flange coupling adapters, RomaGrip, and GripRing Pipe Restrainer. The approval of these products is effective on the date of this letter and will be included in the next Water Approved Materials List updates.

The acceptance and approval of Romac Industries, Inc. products and technology are contingent on the following conditions:

The products approved by the City for water system are the Romac style 501 couplings, Romac EC501 end cap coupling, and Romac FCA501 flange coupling adapters, RomaGrip, and GripRing Pipe Restrainer. The ductile iron products are manufactured at Romac Industries Inc., foundry located at 125 S Sultan Basin Rd., Sultan, WA 98294 and assembled at the Romac Industries Inc., 21919 20th Ave SE, Bothell, WA 98021 plant and corporate headquarters.

1. Romac Industries, Inc. shall be responsible to notify the City of San Diego in advance of any changes in the products, change in ownership of the manufacturing plant, or change in the location of the manufacturing plant.
2. Romac Industries, Inc. shall provide application/installation procedures for the products to ensure the products meet the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction (Greenbook) and City of San Diego's Whitebook 2010. The applicator and installer shall

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

meet the specification conditions required for the proper application/installation of products as specified by Romac Industries, Inc., or any of Romac Industries, Inc. authorized suppliers.

3. Any unilateral action by Romac Industries, Inc., without seeking prior consultation and agreement of the City of San Diego in regard to the above mentioned conditions and limitations shall constitute a breach of agreement resulting in the removal of Romac Industries, Inc., products from the City of San Diego Water Approved Materials List.
