SAN DIEGO – Students of Angier Elementary School will get new and improved playground equipment thanks to the City of San Diego Water Department, which is donating \$8,000 from its Fourth Annual Golf Tournament. On **Monday, September 27, 2004 at 9:10 a.m.**, Councilmember Donna Frye, from Council District 6, and Water Department Director Frank Belock will present the proceeds from the tournament to the school's administrators during a morning school assembly. The school is located at 8450 Hurlbut Street in Serra Mesa.

"It's so important to work together to improve the conditions at our local schools," Councilmember Frye said. "The proceeds from this event will go towards new playground equipment. It's a tremendous gift for our children."
