Wastewater will be purified at North City Plant and delivered to San Vicente Reservoir

Wastewater will be purified at Harbor Drive Treatment Facility and South Bay Plant and delivered to San Vicente and Otay Reservoirs

The Pure Water program will divert approximately 100 million gallons per day (mgd) from the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant to three future water purification facilities located at the North City Water Reclamation Plant, the South Bay Water Reclamation Plant and a future Harbor Drive facility.

An initial 15-mgd water purification facility is planned to be in operation by 2023. The long-term goal of producing 83 mgd of purified water (one-third of San Diego's future drinking water supply) is planned to be reached by 2035.



This local supply of water will enable San Diego to reduce its reliance on imported water and increase its water independence.
