IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Admission to the Turkey Tune Up is not required for submitting an entry for the Lake Sutherland property hunts but is required to buy raffle tickets. The donation is suggested to help cover our chapter expenditures, registration for the Lake Sutherland hunts are free. All entries for the turkey hunt drawing **MUST** in by 1:00 p.m. on February 25, 2006, to be eligible. Deadline will be strictly enforced and one submission per person only. You must be present to register and win. A "Qualified Hunter" **MUST** possess a current CDFG Hunting License and/or CDFG Physically Disabled License or Junior License to submit for hunt drawing. A Blue Handicap Card with a regular Hunting License is also acceptable. Hunts are provided via a partnership of the City Lakes Program, the NWTF and CDFG. Successful winners may choose one hunting partner that meets the above criteria. Reservations are non transferable, however winners may bring the partner of their choice. No one (winner or partner) will be allowed to hunt more than once. First drawn, first choice of available dates and venue. Winners of the Sutherland hunts are required to purchase their permits on February 25; \$20.00 per reservation, plus \$10.00 for each adult hunter and \$5.00 for each youth hunter age (8-15). Hunts will take place on Wednesdays and Saturdays.
