- The "Court of the Port" is currently 188 years old and one of our first-born records highlighting the "First Alcalde" meaning "Mayor" under the Spanish rule
- The original softbound book contained San Diego's true founding documents in the "Book of Records" and "Records of Deeds" from the first Alcalde of San Diego
- This beautifully hand-written softbound book contained twenty-four numerated pages documenting and identifying the first day of record on February 10, 1835
- The "Court of the Port" notates our City's pioneers such as Juan Maria Osuna; Joaquin Cabrillo; Governor Don Luis Antonio Arguello and Jose Bandini who testify, appoint legal authority, bestow final judgements, undertakings of oath and last will and testament

- This aged softbound volume was in great distress and needed triage immediately to circumvent additional damage
- The frayed and ever so delicate volume was then carefully shipped to the conservator for elevated management and preservation to maintain the endearing value of this first generation record



- Tengujo paper is considered to be the thinnest and most durable mending paper, historically proven fact that tengujo remains stable for a prolonged period of time
- Clamshell housing is superior to other archival standards they are acid-free, pH is between 8 and 9.5. and guaranteed to be age resistant
- Hydroxypropyl Methylcellulose typically functions as thickening, dispersing and stabilizing agents, and has good solubility to water or other organic solvents
