- 1. La Jolla Improvement 2 Project** – Replace approximately 3.37 miles (17,792 feet) of water distribution mains, replace 1.22 miles (6,458 feet) of sewer mains. The project is in Council District 1, within La Jolla Planning Group (Reyna V. Rendon Roja, Assistant Civil Engineer) – Action Item
- 2. La Jolla Street Scape Plan** – The plan intends to create a pedestrian promenade along Prospect Street, improve crosswalk safety and corner pop-out areas on Girard Avenue, expand art offerings and enhance overall street experience in The Village. (Mark Steele, M.W. Steele Group) – Action Item
- 3. Request for Red Curb - 7330-7336 La Jolla Blvd.** – Homeowner requesting that half or all of the curb that fronts 7330-7336 La Jolla Blvd. become a red curb again. Extreme challenges in seeing oncoming traffic from alley exit to La Jolla Blvd. (Jeanne Liem) – Action Item
- 4. Valet Parking in Residential Streets** – Formerly a public comment from Nancy Manno, we are seeking a more definitive policy for parking/valet services on private and surface streets which are causing dangerous conditions. (Diane Kane, Nancy Manno) – Discussion Item
