Please vote NO on the Mandelbaum projects! The lots are too small/houses too big! In addition to my 2018 objections resubmitted, applicant has:

- * submitted vague renderings (not plans) late, can't tell what he's building
- * included the 300-ft circle analysis he has used in the past it is full of incorrect information, i.e. he lists our house as a 1-story house and has based his FAR calculation a 1-story house. Our house is 3 stories, FAR is much lower. Side set-back info is wrong also.
- * For the Lot 5 house, he is calling it a one-story house with a basement. He has excluded the entire 1st floor from coverage calculations, because he's labeling it a basement. The northern façade is exposed, and drawings appear as though the land covers nearly all of the "basement" on the sides. Sliding-scale % required to include in coverage calculations for exposed basements, based on the amount of visible s.f.
- * No set backs listed for west side of Lot 5 house
- * Not clear if roof eaves are considered in setbacks in the past he has excluded eaves and measured from the walls.
