

**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Overnight Full Road Closures at Friars Road between Napa Street and Sea World Drive from March 13-17**

March 10, 2022

Starting on Sunday, March 13 and ending on Thursday, March 17, Friars Road from Napa Street to Sea World Drive will be fully closed during overnight hours (9 p.m. to 5 a.m.) to all vehicle, bicycle, and pedestrian traffic for the City of San Diego Morena Pump Station project, part of the Pure Water Program. The road will remain accessible for emergency responders. During the closures, crews will be working to install sound walls, and there will be associated construction noise.

These full eastbound and westbound closures between Sea World Drive and Napa Street will be in place during the following dates and times:

- Sunday, March 13 at 9 p.m. to Monday, March 14 at 5 a.m.
- Monday, March 14 at 9 p.m. to Tuesday, March 15 at 5 a.m.
- Tuesday, March 15 at 9 p.m. to Wednesday, March 16 at 5 a.m.
- Wednesday, March 16 at 9 p.m. to Thursday, March 17 at 5 a.m.

**To safely complete work on major support infrastructure on Friars Road as part of the Morena Pump Station project, the westbound vehicle lanes from Napa Street to Sea World Drive are closed at all times until summer 2022 as part of the first phase of traffic control.**

**What To Expect:** During the full road closures, construction crews will be working to install sound walls, which will help alleviate noise from the continuing Friars Road construction work that is part of the Morena Pump Station project. The posted detour for these road closures are Napa Street, Morena Boulevard, Tecolote Road, and Sea World Drive. After the temporary closures, Friars Road between Napa Street and Sea World Drive will reopen to eastbound traffic only and two-way bicycle traffic. All nearby businesses will remain open and accessible. Please follow all posted signage and crew member directions near the work zone and expect delays in the area.

**When:** Friars Road between Napa Street and Sea World Drive will be fully closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. between Sunday, March 13 and Thursday, March 17, 2022. Work for this project is ongoing and the current regular traffic configuration (eastbound access only) is permitted to be in place through July 12, 2022. The work on Friars Road is primarily scheduled for Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**Why:** Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply. The Morena Pump Station project is one of several major water infrastructure projects that are part of Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on [morena.purewatersd.org](https://morena.purewatersd.org).
