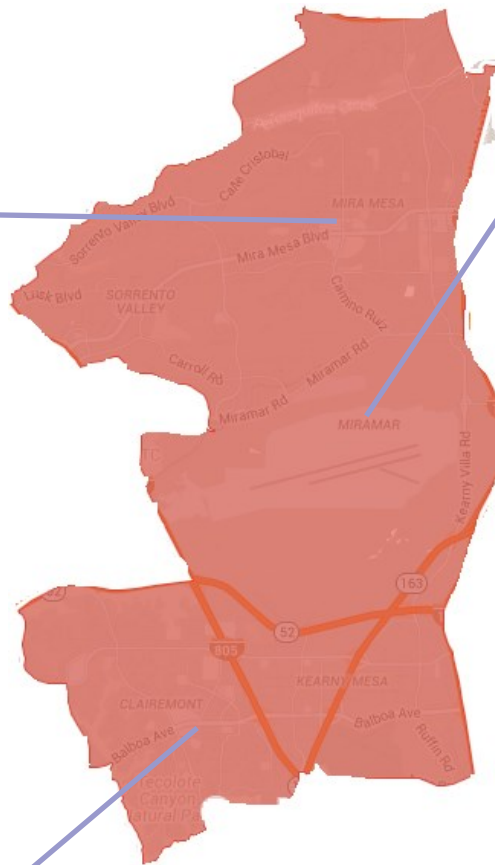




District 6 Dispatch | May 2018
