

**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Overnight Construction on Friars Road near Napa Street Extended through  
May 6**

May 4, 2022

During the week of May 2, construction crews will work overnight on Friars Road near Napa Street for the City of San Diego Morena Pump Station project, part of the Pure Water Program. Work hours will be from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night. During the overnight work, crews will be performing work on sewer lines while sewer flows are at their lowest during nighttime hours.

The nighttime work will occur during the following dates and times:

- Tuesday, May 3 at 9 p.m. to Wednesday, May 4 at 5 a.m.
- Wednesday, May 4 at 9 p.m. to Thursday, May 5 at 5 a.m.
- Thursday, May 5 at 9 p.m. to Friday, May 6 at 5 a.m.

**To safely complete work on major support infrastructure on Friars Road as part of the Morena Pump Station project, the westbound vehicle lanes from Napa Street to Sea World Drive are closed at all times until February 2023 as part of the first phase of traffic control.**

**What To Expect:** During the nighttime work, construction crews will be performing sewer work by installing a plug to prepare for sewer abandonment at the intersection of Friars Road and Napa Street for the Morena Pump Station project. Noise and light impacts are expected in the area, however; crews are aware of nearby residents and will minimize impacts to the fullest extent possible.

**When:** Friars Road at Napa Street from Tuesday, May 3 through Thursday, May 5. Work hours will be 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night. Work for this project is ongoing and the current regular traffic configuration (eastbound access only) is permitted to be in place through February 2023. The work on Friars Road is primarily scheduled for Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**Why:** Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply. The Morena Pump Station project is one of several major water infrastructure projects that are part of Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on [morena.purewatersd.org](https://morena.purewatersd.org).
