SUBJECT: Reappointment to the Commission on Gang Prevention and Intervention

I am reappointing Elizabeth Bustos, Sheryl Harris and Jamie Wilson to the Commission on Gang Prevention and Intervention.

Ms. Bustos is a public health policy and community engagement executive and currently serves as the Community Development Liaison for the County of San Diego. She previously served as the Director of Community Engagement for Be There San Diego, a coalition of patients, communities, healthcare systems, and others working together to prevent heart attacks and strokes in San Diego, and the Community Relations Director for San Ysidro Health. She received a Bachelor of Arts in social work from San Diego State University. She is being reappointed to a two-year term ending July 1, 2024, in the Social Services Representative Seat.

Ms. Harris is a retired special education teacher who developed and implemented individualized education plans for special education students, addressed specific needs and abilities. She received her Bachelor of Arts in Psychology from the University of Illinois, Chicago, and a Master of Education in Special Education from the University of San Diego. She is being reappointed to the District 2 Representative seat for a two-year term ending July 1, 2025. I thank Councilmember Campbell for this nomination.

Ms. Wilson currently serves as a Community Organizer through SAY San Diego and is a certified Gang Specialist through the National Gang Enforcement. Additionally, she has functioned as a San Diego Gang Injunction Researcher and Auditor, researching gang laws, policies, procedures, and program outcomes. Ms. Wilson is a Lived Experience Expert, having navigated

through the state's first youth gang documentation challenge as the parent of a child who was documented in the CalGang database.
