This weekend continues to inspire and transform lives as well as change the perception of what people with permanent physical challenges can accomplish. Nearly 300**

challenged athletes and hundreds of more fundraisers participated in the events during the 2019 weekend and raised over \$2.7 Million. 2019 was the largest year for CAF, providing 3,260 individual grants for adaptive sports equipment, training and competition expenses equating to \$4.8 million awarded to individuals with physical challenges over 103 different sports, in all 50 states and 42 different countries.
