1. **Type of Event:** Half Marathon Run
2. **When, Day and Date:** Saturday, October 1, 2022
3. **Dates: Load In:** Saturday, October 1, 2022
4. **Times?**
 - Load in:** 3:00AM
 - Event:** 6:30AM - Half Marathon Start
 - Load out:** 8:00AM
5. **Location: Road Closure:** Old SeaWorld Dr., bike lane on Quivira, Dana Landing Rd., bike lane and single lane of W Mission Bay Dr. bridge.
6. **Parking Lot Closure:** De Anza Cove Parking Lot, Sunset Point Park Lot, 90 spots in Ventura Cove Parking Lot
7. **Parking Plan: Shuttle Plan:** Buses will shuttle participants from Pacific Beach from 5am to 6am. Individuals can also street park and uber back to their vehicles post run.
8. **Traffic Plan:** Will work with Special Event Traffic Controllers to help manage car and shuttle flow during the morning drop off prior to the start of the half marathon.
