**Event Description:** A two-day country music festival experience that combines the breathtaking views of Mission Bay, an expansive selection of culinary tastings from local restaurants, Ferris wheel ride and interactive games with great music from some of the biggest names in country music. Sound will also be repeated through towers for a balanced sound production. The stage will also be strategically pointed towards the marshes and the path covered by the least number of residential homes. We are asking for 11pm sound off on Saturday however, open, and willing to work with the city for a different curfew.
