502. Association of National Olympic Committee) (ANOC) World Beach Games – Vincent E. Mudd, Chairman of the San Diego Exploratory Foundation

Mr. Mudd updated committee on the World Beach Games. The final process is the special event permit. They will be using 70 acres in Mission Beach, Mariner's Cove and Bonita East and West. ANOC World Beach Games are a global celebration of beach and urban sports, featuring a fusion of lifestyle and sports performances. September 2017 will see San Diego's world famous beaches host this first ever event.

Mission Bay Park Committee will put ANOC on the agenda for June 2017 and take an action of support.

503. 2016 Rock 'N Roll San Diego Marathon Information/Updates – Natalia Mendez-Coordinator, Community Relations

The 2016 course route has undergone a few changes. In relation to Mission Bay, the course will no longer run north of the Hilton Resort and Spa, which will allow for the I-5 exits to Clairemont Drive to stay open, improving access. Runners will exit the area from Tecolote North Shores Park on E. Mission Bay Drive at approximately 12pm. It is important to note that the road closures are in place slightly longer than previous years. There will be access to I-5 south on ramp from Sea World Drive and westbound access on Sea World Drive will be permitted from I-5 North Sea World Drive exit. Access will be restricted from I-5 south exit until approximately 12:30pm.
