SUBJECT: Allocation of Council District Three Fiscal Year 2013 Discretionary TOT Funds to Mainly Mozart and Classics for Kids, Inc. for Youth Arts-Based Learning Programs

I am pleased to allocate \$7,000 of my Council Office's Fiscal Year 2013 discretionary TOT funds to support youth arts-based learning programs offered by Mainly Mozart and Classics for Kids, Inc.

The \$5,500 allocation for Mainly Mozart will support its May-June 2013 concert series. Mainly Mozart serves the San Diego region with critically and popularly acclaimed concerts featuring many of the world's top orchestral and chamber musicians, educational programs that serve over 20,000 children annually, and community outreach programs that reach thousands of members of the region who may not otherwise be exposed.

The \$1,500 allocation for Classics for Kids, Inc. will support its Bluegrass and Bach concert series, providing interactive educational orchestra concerts and delivering arts-based learning programs for children in kindergarten through grade five. The innovative programs provided by Classics for Kids, Inc. help children achieve academically using music as a catalyst, developing the next generation of educated members of our community.

I respectfully request that a total of \$7,000 be transferred as described above, from the Council District Three TOT Fund: 200205 | Cost Center: 1414111214 | GL: 512059,

and be used to augment the existing contracts between the City and Mainly Mozart and Classics for Kids, Inc.
