SUBJECT: Appointment of Douglas Kot to the Economic and Environmental Sustainability Task Force

I am pleased to appoint Douglas Kot as the District Three representative to the Economic and Environmental Sustainability Task Force. He will replace Nicole Capretz, who resigned as the Chair due to her current role as the Director of Environmental Policy in the Interim Mayor's office.

Mr. Kot is an architect and LEED certified planner uniquely qualified to advise the city on sustainability. He is the Executive Director of the San Diego Green Building Council and has provided consulting services and advocacy to various organizations for energy efficiency and renewable energy since 2000. He has advised on and assisted with implementation of energy master plans for buildings and communities and has advised major municipalities throughout the U.S. in climate action and adaptation planning.

Doug has also been working with the City of San Diego Environmental Services Department and Development Services Department staff since 2009 on green building and energy policy goals including the sustainable building incentive policy, zero net energy buildings and others. Finally, Doug is working with North Park Main Street to develop an energy and water benchmarking protocol for small businesses and helping to make the facilities in Balboa Park more sustainable.
