SUBJECT: Conference with Legal Counsel Regarding Existing Litigation

I am in receipt of your memo regarding Non-Agenda Public Comment at City Council Meetings dated October 7, 2014. The matter discussed in the memo is related to existing litigation, *Center for Local Government Accountability v. City of San Diego*, a case involving an allegation that the City is in violation of the Brown Act (Cal. Gov't Code § 54950, et. seq) by not allowing non-agenda public comment each day that the Council holds meetings. I request the City Attorney's Office place this matter on the October 21, 2014 Closed Session agenda and update the Mayor and City Council on the status of the litigation. Until the full Council has been given the chance to deliberate and give further direction on the matter, there will be no changes to the docket or to the current practice of how non-agenda public comment is handled.
