The 4300 block of Bancroft Street, between 4372/4376 Bancroft Street The 4300 block of Bancroft Street, between 4343/4351 Bancroft Street Oregon Street south of Polk Avenue, east side Oregon Street north of Lincoln Avenue, east side 33rd Street south of Monroe Avenue, west side Utah Street south of Howard Avenue, west side Utah Street south of Polk Avenue, east side Utah Street south of Lincoln Avenue, east side Utah Street north of University, east side Ohio Street south of Meade Avenue, east side Ohio Street north of El Cajon Boulevard, west side Russ Boulevard east of 25th Street Russ Boulevard west of 26th Street Madison Avenue, between 32nd Street and Bancroft Street, southwest corner Felton Avenue south of Monroe Avenue, west side Felton Avenue north of Meade Avenue, west side Hawley Boulevard south of Madison Avenue, east side Swift Avenue south of Monroe Avenue, east side Swift Avenue north of Meade Avenue, east side Boundary Street south of Madison Avenue, west side
