SUBJECT: Environment Committee Priorities for 2015

I feel fortunate be appointed as a member of the San Diego City Council Environment Committee. Per your request, I am including my priorities for committee discussion and action below.

- Climate Action Plan: The Environment Committee should receive regular updates from City staff on the status of the Climate Action Plan, including a schedule for approval and implementation.
- Energy Audit Requirements: In conjunction with the Climate Action Plan's goals
 of reducing greenhouse gas emissions in commercial and residential buildings, it
 may be beneficial to explore legislation requiring periodic energy audits, starting
 with City-owned buildings, to establish a baseline. Several other cities have
 implemented this requirement and are seeing significant energy reductions and
 cost savings.
- Water Conservation Plan for City Sites: The Environment Committee should consider developing a plan to retrofit all City-owned properties with drought tolerant landscaping and weather-based irrigation controllers. Some City golf courses have already implemented these improvements.
